MAKE A TOAST patiently ridden lagging far off the early pace, gained momentum mid turn, collared WINTER'S CHILD in upper stretch, slowly edged away at the sixteenth to win going away being ridden out. WINTER'S CHILD stalked to the far turn, moved clear at the quarter pole, was headed by the winner in upper stretch, battled hard to deep stretch, yielded stubbornly proving a game second best. RED BEADS broke alertly and set a solid pace, dueled with the runner up to mid turn, had nothing left by upper stretch giving way, finished leg weary just saving the show position. SNICKER STAR was slightly bumped from both leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, failed to factor. SAMURAI PARK broke out bumping SNICKER STAR leaving the gate, hustled up stalked the pace briefly, began to fade middle of the second turn, finished well beaten.
