BELLEOFTHEVALLEY unhurried early advanced to contention on the far turn, loomed four deep at mid track in upper stretch angling down to the three path edging past TURBO CANNON in the final yards. TURBO CANNON broke alertly nursing a short lead through the far turn, digging in from the two path down the lane would cede to outside pressure. KING HARRY went evenly through the backside, gained threatening on the far turn, extending in the four path down the lane was outfinished. BEAR'S KNIGHT prompted the pace through the backside, continued pressing moving alongside TURBO CANNON on the far turn, battling in upper stretch would wear down late. BORREGO ROAD off slowly gave a prompted middle move, saved ground to bid in upper stretch then wavered late near the rail. SCOTTKEITH'SKITTEN stalked the pace looming behind horses in upper stretch, swung out six wide late would hang. FISKBURG tracked early then gave way on the far turn, was eased to the wire.
