Footnotes

UNBRIDLED CAT rushed and pressed JUST MILITARY from the start, raced towards the inside throughout, was angling to mid track top of the lane but came back towards the rail when leader stayed mid track, vied for the lead inside the eighth pole, went clear under strong handling to win going away. JUST MILITARY broke sharply, nursed the lead on the turn, remained off the rail entering the stretch, dueled in deep stretch, proved no match but was a game second best. FAX MACHINE was jammed at the start when MASTER THE GAME bore in causing trouble, settled in the second flight, rallied to split foes at the quarter pole, angled out upper stretch, loomed to the sixteenth pole, flattened out. FLAVOUR FLAVOUR raced evenly early, came along the rail to rally upper stretch, improved position but was no threat. KING DREAMER showed good speed, raced up close to mid turn while between rivals, was hard ridden but came up empty in the drive. NEW GUINEA was jammed hard at the break, trailed early, angled into the lane under a drive, gave a belated gain but never factored. EXTREME D'OR hustled and chased the pace while four wide, urged throughout, lacked needed rally. LIVELY EXIT raced evenly and wide on the turn, roused from the three eighths pole, weakened in the lane. FOOTBALL PASSER flashed speed from the gate, gave way top of the stretch. MASTER THE GAME bore in at the break to create havoc, trailed early, never involved.
