SWEET TALKIN FELLA stalked the pace sitting patient off a loose DERBY NOISE through the backside, reeled in the leader on the far turn going clear in upper stretch widening under urging along the inside. POLITICAL PROMISE went evenly through the backside moving to contention on the far turn, saved ground into upper stretch angling off the rail outside the eighth pole rallying up for place. A SINGLE MAN unhurried early rallied to bid emerging off SWEET TALKIN FELLA in upper stretch, no match for the winner would extend in the four path hanging late. DERBY NOISE hustled out was used while well clear through the backside, began to come back to the pack on the far turn wearing down near the rail in upper stretch. EL RAYITO chased a loose DERBY NOISE through the backside then tired on the far turn. FIVE STAR DEBT was always outrun. RED ILLUSION away slowly would stay back throughout. SECTION A done early was eased to wire.
