**Footnotes**

GENERAL STAFF sent early, duled with UNIQUE INCIDENT from the start, alternated for the lead around the turn and to deep stretch, inched clear coming to the wire for a hard earned victory. UNIQUE INCIDENT showed good speed, went head to head with the winner from the start to deep stretch, was outfinished late then just held on to save second place in a solid effort. THE RIDER OF UNIQUE INCIDENT CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF GENERAL STAFF FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH, AFTER REVIEWING THE TAPE, THE STEWARDS QUICKLY DISMISSED THE CLAIM, RESULTS STOOD AS IS. MARQ OF LOVE settled along the rail in mid pack, launched rally top of the lane, angled out mid stretch for room, surged late just missing second place in a game try. KING OF T MOUNTAIN settled in mid pack, came four wide into the lane, came in bumping TEMPER'S DESTINY upper stretch, continued on in willingly manner finishing with interest. KING T C settled in the second flight, mildly bid in upper stretch, leveled off needing more late. EL FLACO tracked early on, bid four wide giving chase entering the stretch, flattened out mid stretch. WYO BANDITO trailed early racing mid track, swung seven wide into the lane, failed to threaten. RAPID DEVELOPMENT varied little traveling towards the inside, failed to respond when roused, no threat. TEMPER'S DESTINY forwardly placed racing between foes around the turn, raced three to four wide entering the stretch giving chase, was bumped by KING OF T MOUNTAIN in upper stretch, faded mid stretch. TALK TO DA MANAGER was always outrun racing mid track, showed little.
