NIAGARA EXPRESS pressured the pace moving in close quarters between horses through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch drawing out in the two path. VERONIE veered in leaving the gate, advanced on the turn taking aim from the three path in upper stretch, no match for the winner held for place. MY SISTER CONNIE away slowly trailed through the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch gave a mild rally abreast rivals. BEST CAMPER raced evenly in mid pack through the turn, extending from mid track in upper stretch improved a bit late. SMACKY'S FAN broke alertly pressing then chasing through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading in the four path. MS DRAMA QUEEN slow early came five wide in upper stretch angling inside with little response. BOLD TRAJECTORY sent hard pressured the pace through the turn then wore out along the rail in upper stretch. OILVE OIL TOO remained sluggish throughout.
