ASSIPATTLE settled early was beginning to move on the turn when forced to steady in close quarters near the quarter pole, regrouped quickly in upper stretch edging past ATLANTIC DANCER gamely in the closing yards. ATLANTIC DANCER raced evenly early on, rushed up four deep to put a head in front on the turn, duelled from the inside down the stretch ceding late in the two path. DREAM OF PERTH tracked the pace edging closer on the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch vied evenly from the eighth pole. SULLY'S LANDING chased early then pressed up along the inside on the turn, dueling from the rail in upper stretch would wear down late. CALM NIGHT away slowly was never close improving past tired ones. DIGGIN UP A RUCKUS a step slow early was never involved. GIN KINGS broke alertly pressuring the pace through the turn, gave way in close at the head of the lane. SENATOR BILL sent hard pressured the early pace, was squeezed and forced to take up near the quarter pole dropping back with no recovery. TRICK O MAN was always outrun.
