Footnotes

BEYOND THE OCEAN broke alertly but smartly took back to stalk a contested pace, sat patient to the quarter pole, bid three wide running abreast rivals to vie for the lead leaving the quarter pole, drew off from upper stretch and held safe under a drive to the wire. PATCHAROANY raced evenly at mid track, hard ridden from top of the stretch, surged late just nipping LIGHTING RAY for second place in a willing effort. LIGHTING RAY sent hard, vied for the lead from the start, fought hard to upper stretch, proved no match for the winner and then was just edged out of second place in last jumps, good effort. SUGAR DUST well placed racing along the rail tracking a contested pace, angled out splitting foes in upper stretch, failed to respond despite being hard ridden. SPECIALNESS raced evenly traveling four wide around the bend, lacked response in the lane never menacing. PADDY TAP was hard used battling for the lead running along the rail, began to fade mid stretch, used up. SWARR lacked speed trailing around the turn, drifted out five wide upper stretch, showed little.
