WHISKEYONTEROCKS well rated fired into the far turn sweeping clear into upper stretch, in charge the final eighth won ridden out in the two path. SPIRITWOOD unhurried early angled four wide while responding into upper stretch, dueled abreast BONNISTAR prevailing for place. BONNISTAR raced evenly in mid pack to the half, gave a mild rally on the far turn vying from the three path upper stretch, no match for the winner gave all late. CHOW WAGON slow early angled to mid track in upper stretch giving an even finish. BUCKEYE SLEW stalked the pace through the backside chasing on the far turn, would wear out in upper stretch. AVENUESNALLEYWAYS (IRE) sent clear led the way through the far turn then wilted in upper stretch. COPPER CASCADE tracked evenly through the far turn then flattened out in upper stretch. ROAD NOT TRAVELED struggled well back.
