YOU PAY THE BILL raced 5-6 wide backstretch, asked near the far turn, cleared near the 1/4 pole, remained off the rail in upper stretch, drew off while being ridden out. TIA MARQUETRY slow early while being rated back, asked past the 1/2, gained on the turn and bid 3 wide entering the stretch, received strong left handed encouragement in the drive to get the place position, willing. SKIP THE FUSS sent to duel for the lead while between foes down the backstretch, gained a slim lead far turn, was headed by YOU PAY THE BILL on the turn, had no answer for that rival but held game for third place while tiring in the lane. MY LADY CRUELLA raced second flight along the inside, rallied on the turn, was hard ridden in the lane but needed more late, evenly. PEACE showed good speed to vie for the lead while three wide to the half, began to chase on the turn, tired in the lane from early duel. WHAT'S SO FUNNY raced evenly early on while wide, asked on the turn and was hard ridden for the stretch run, improved position while being no threat. AWAITING GOOD NEWS was taken back leaving the gate, raced inside, asked but lacked needed rally. ZAGOR'S WALTER'S H was slow early, trailed, never involved. IT IS PRIVATE stalked duel while racing wide down the backstretch, gave way on the turn. GOLDEN DRAGON (FR) sent hard racing inside to duel, battled to the 1/2, gave way on the turn and finished weary.
