**Footnotes**

SEISMOLOGIST showed sharp speed dueling with DEADLY DEALER from the start, alternated with that rival to upper stretch, drew off late under strong handling. DEADLY DEALER broke alertly, matched strides with SEISMOLOGIST to the three sixteenths, could not keep pace from upper stretch, dug in nearing the wire to preserve the place position. FASTER THAN FLASH stalked a hot duel, rallied along the rail top of the lane, was outgamed in deep stretch vying for second place, hard try. TIME CRAFTER was off a step slow, settled running off the rail, swung five wide top of the lane, failed to threaten while under a stiff drive. BOOGER STREET was well placed tracking duelers around the bend, lacked response when asked and tired mid stretch. BLUES CROSSING was quickly outrun, did find stride in mid stretch, was going well at the finish line but never factored.
