Footnotes

MOONLIGHT DREAMER broke alertly, rider sat patient while dueling for the lead going around the turn, asked leaving the quarter pole, quickly drew off to leave the field behind coming to the furlong marker, won easily and was in hand coming to the finish line. JUJU'S GIRL slightly hopped as the gate opened, rushed up to press MOONLIGHT DREAMER in the early going, began to chase from the quarter pole, battled willingly to gain the place position in good effort. REACHFORTHECASTLE rushed a four wide bid on the turn, put a head in front at the quarter pole, was no match for MOONLIGHT DREAMER in mid stretch, weakened in deep stretch and just held on to the show position. HELEN LOUISE was off late and trailed to top of the lane, swung six wide under a drive, mildly bid to improve placing but was no factor. BONNE BAY was hustled early, gave chase on the bend, never menaced. DELAWARE TWITCH was moved off the rail to race mid track at the three eighths pole, remained wide for the stretch run, failed to factor. BLAZINETT was hard ridden leaving the gate, chased briefly, gave way past the quarter pole.
