Footnotes

LAKE MERRITT was nicely rating racing towards the inside to the three eighths pole, angled out rallying four wide entering the stretch, quickly blew clear to take control in upper stretch, widened margin under steady handling. KAKHAO settled towards the rear under a rating, roused mid turn, hit stride in upper stretch, split foes a sixteenth out, surged gamely getting second place. MCBEAN trailed to the far turn, advanced mid turn, came four wide top of the stretch, going well at the finish but never threatened. YES IT IS moved off to a clear lead, set the pace under a rating, headed nearing the top of the lane, had little left inside the eighth pole. BEAU MOMENTOUS was brushed by BLACK STORM leaving the gate, hustled up to track the pace running four to five wide to the half, rallied on the bend angling towards the rail, held a menacing position in upper stretch, flattened out mid stretch. WILDNATIVEWARRIOR raced up close to the far turn, started to tire near the quarter pole, was all done by mid stretch. CHEYCONS REVENGE raced in the second flight throughout, failed to respond when roused, no factor. POLAR IMAGE was forwardly placed, stalked to the half, gave way leaving the quarter pole, used up. BLACK STORM veered out at the break, dropped off to trail at the half, never involved.
