BLUE'S LAST pressed for the lead from the start, battled outside of VARIABLE from the quarter pole, was carried out wider by that rival turning for home, slowly edged clear nearing the wire under a stiff drive. BELLARIFFIC unhurried from the gate racing towards the rear, swung five wide upper stretch, gave belated surge just getting up for second place in a willing manner. VARIABLE urged leaving the gate, set a pressured pace around the turn, drifted out a bit top of the lane, fought hard to the sixteenth pole, weakened late being nipped for second place. TOES ON THE CURB was briefly steadied going into the far turn when CHAPEL RIVER angled inside, moved out leaving the quarter pole, came four wide upper stretch, improved placing but never menaced. CHAPEL RIVER angled to the rail shortly after the start, roused from the quarter pole, lacked response. RED ZINN trailed soon after the start, angled to the rail for the stretch run, passed a couple of weary rivals never factoring. JUMP THE FENCE hustled and chased traveling off the rail, began to fade in upper stretch racing five wide. PURELY FANCY showed brief speed running along the rail, gave way at the three sixteenths and was eased across the finish line.
