Footnotes

SHOT OF KELA raced up close along the rail from the start, bid at the three eighths pole, came out a bit brushing BLYDE RIVER BOY, drew off from upper stretch and won easily being ridden out. LIFE GUARD tracked down the backside, set down at the quarter pole, chased the winner traveling four wide in the stretch run, failed to menace while finishing a willing second best. AUDITORIUM hustled from the gate, vied mid turn racing three wide, began to tire mid stretch, held off others to settle for third place. TETON STAR settled in the second flight, swung five wide top of the lane, improved position but failed to threaten. COUNTRY HUMOR well placed racing along the rail, was in tight and steadied briefly entering the stretch, remained inside to mid stretch and had to steady again at the eighth pole to avoid a fading BLYDE RIVER BOY, angled out finishing evenly. LAKE LUCERNE lacked speed and raced wide throughout, lacked response when asked, no factor. BLYDE RIVER BOY broke alertly, led to the far turn, vied for the lead on the bend racing between rivals, weakened in upper stretch and faltered inside the eighth pole. AUTRY was off slowly and trailed throughout, never involved.
