THREEWISEMEN unhurried and settled towards the rear, roused leaving the quarter pole, closed in quickly on a trio of duelers in deep stretch, split foes with fifty yards to go and surged clear under strong handling. SMOOTH TRANSITION pressed for the early lead running along the rail, was in tight going into the far turn and brushed the rail briefly, settled mid turn racing up close, angled out three wide turning for home, vied abreast rivals in deep stretch but was outgamed by the winner in last jumps missing in a very good effort. LAPILE CREEK showed good speed dueling for the lead, alternated for the lead to mid stretch, yielded late holding onto third place. TAP TIPY TAP slightly bobbled at the break but quickly recovered rushing up to vie for the lead, matched strides to deep stretch running along the rail, weakened late from earlier efforts being outfinished for a minor award in a hard try. ROBYNS AFAIR settled in good tracking position, rallied four wide mid stretch, needed more late besting rest. PATROL LEADER lacked speed racing in the second flight at mid track, swung six wide under a drive upper stretch, failed to respond. MERLIN BAY trailed won the backside racing wide, angled towards the inside mid turn, never factored. TWO AS ONE dueled down the backside running between foes, gave way entering the stretch, used up.
