KINDA KINDA in close early stalked through the turn, bidding inside upper stretch would angle out late getting up in time. BATTLETOWN INN broke sharply setting a pressured pace through the turn, digging in from the two path was grabbed in the final strides. NEWPORT LULU tracked the pace through the turn coming three wide upper stretch, looming late would hang. BOLD PEAKS chased early then was shuffled back on the turn, split horses in upper stretch finishing well. CHAPEL SINGER slow early saved ground to upper stretch improving late along the rail. HELEN'S TROLLIE raced evenly off the pace lacking late surge. VENUS DRIVE played no factor. MARTINI JANE gave hard pursuit through the turn then tired in upper stretch. EASYBABY bumped at the break gave a mild move on the turn then flattened out wide in upper stretch. MOGEY was never involved.
