BIG BOY TYSON broke sharply to the early lead fighting the rider when getting out on the turn, kept on the inside in upper stretch would draw clear and hold firm. HIYA KID a step slow through the turn gave a mild rally inside the eighth pole getting up for place in the four path. DARK WINTER away slowly was outrun through the turn, lost ground to upper stretch improving with even action in the six path. NOLINS SIEGER broke alertly drifting wide while pursuing BIG BOY TYSON through the turn, raced six and seven path in upper stretch wearing down late. OCTIBBEHA WARRIOR slow early saved ground while always outrun. FLYING JOE off slowly remained sluggish throughout. CHUCKY CAN FLY raced evenly early moving up a bit on the turn, would weaken the final eighth. GRAND MUSIC struggled in the back.
