DARING JULIE crowded at the break, angled out sweeping to contention 4 wide through the turn, collared DEBIT OR CREDIT in mid stretch, edged clear driving. DEBIT OR CREDIT hustled out to prompt the pace, dueled inside of THAT'S ALL RIGHT through the turn, wrested a short lead into upper stretch, collared from the outside by DARING JULIE nearing the 1/16 pole, proved no match hanging on late for place. MELODY MAIDEN came out bumping TIME OFTHE ESSENCE at the break, remained well back racing to the 1/4 pole, circled out 5 wide into lane, found stride under the whip, closed in too late. THAT'S ALL RIGHT broke sharply to go on the pace, pressed abreast DEBIT OR CREDIT as the pair moved in tandem to the lane, extended for more in drive, had enough inside the 1/16 pole giving way. TIME OFTHE ESSENCE was bumped and crowded by MELODY MAIDEN at the break, raced evenly through the turn, had no late rally. MARHABA dropped back early, raced wide into the lane playing no factor. BERKSHIRE PRINCESS showed some early speed, pursued a slow pace to mid turn, began to waver nearing the 1/4 pole, folded up at the top of the lane. LITTLE KITTY CAT was always outrun. PIONEERESS offered little. QUIET DUCHESS broke alertly to press the pace, moved between horses into the turn, dropped off racing to the 1/4 pole, wilted from there.
