VICTORY CURE hustled to the early lead was worked clear into upper stretch, dug in from the eighth pole finding more. TAXICAB chased then pressed three wide on the turn, ceding a clear lead to the winner in upper stretch held well for place. WILD WAY swung out wide early, went evenly to upper stretch gaining some there near mid track. MOON IS A STAR went evenly saving ground to upper stretch, weakened late. DAKOTA FREEWAY saving ground to upper stretch proved no menace. CRAFTY MATCH slow early was never involved. THREE MIRACLES was always a step slow inside. FISTICUFF labored throughout. STASH THE BOOTS gave hard pursuit through the turn then wilted along the inside. GO GO MOJO had brief foot then gave way abruptly on the turn.
