MATTY'S EQUALIZER rushed into the far turn, dueled briefly with ROMAS SPIRIT, cleared at the quarter pole and angled inside in upper stretch, held firm to the finish under steady encouragement. ROMAS SPIRIT sent early, dueled with the winner to mid turn, gave chase from upper stretch, was held safe while proving a willing second best. IAM A BILLIONAIRE settled early, rallied from the quarter pole, came three to four wide into the lane chasing top pair, needed more late besting rest. CAPOTE BULL urged around the bend racing along the rail, improved placing but failed to menace. HE'SADREAMCOMETRUE hustled leaving the gate, stalked to pair to mid turn, angled out leaving the quarter pole, came up empty in the stretch run. ONE HUNDRED LAUGHS trailed soon after the start, raced along the rail throughout, offered little. SIR EDWARD was off a step slow, raced mid track around the turn, swung out six to seven wide upper stretch, no factor. WILDCAT HUMOR raced briefly in mid pack, retreated from the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
