**Footnotes**

BALTO MORE sent hard wrested the lead then widened to the turn, digging in from the four and three path down the lane held off an inside challenge from HENRY THE LOVER finding more at the end. HENRY THE LOVER tracked the pace coming three wide to upper stretch, angling down to the rail lost momentum proving no match late. CALL THE GUY bumped at the break would chase the pace through the turn, looming four wide in upper stretch weakened under a drive. SPEEDY TUXEDO away slowly saved ground to upper stretch playing no factor. BLACKBERRY WINTER was always outrun. MOUNTAIN A. P. pressed early then gave way on the turn.
