Footnotes

COACH DOUG rushed to the lead racing two to three wide, challenged by DIZENER at the quarter pole, turned that rival away by mid stretch drawing off for a convincing victory. DIZENER stalked COACH DOUG down the backside, gained on the turn and almost drew even at the quarter pole, was turned away by upper stretch and gamely proved to be second best. KYLE'S TREASURY tracked the winner down the backstretch, asked on the bend, bid four wide at the quarter pole, chased top pair in the lane but never menaced. SWISS RESERVE was just a step slow from the gate, rushed up running along the rail, lacked response when roused, beat others. AMERICAN INFLUENCE showed good speed, stalked then chased the winner from mid turn, weakened in mid stretch traveling along the rail. MISTER WEINKE lacked speed and raced mid track, varied little despite being hard ridden. BORDER CUVEE lacked speed, went by tired foes to mildly improve placing, no threat. SNOWRAJ raced evenly at mid pack, roused to no avail, no threat. GLORIED settled in the second flight, faded from the quarter pole, no factor. MISTER TORNADO was always outrun, dull effort.
