KEEN CASE sent hard pressured to clear on the turn, angled toward mid track in upper stretch widened under a drive. WILDCAT SPECIAL carried out by A. P. SIERRA at the break would chase close up through the turn, extended in the six path down the stretch proved no match holding on for place. CASH ADVANCE tracked early gaining to threaten on the turn, angled seven wide in upper stretch finished evenly. STELLAR HOPE was jammed steadying shortly after the break, stayed back through the turn proving no menace. WOODSWIND pressed early then faded back on the turn. DUBAI GLITTER was jammed and forced to steady shortly after the break, never recovered finishing seven wide. A. P. SIERRA bore out jamming up rivals after the break, pressed the pace through the turn then gave way along the inside in upper stretch. HAV'N A FOG ATTACK was jammed up and forced to steady at the break laboring after.
