Footnotes

MORE THAN A REASON raced up close to a contested pace, bid between foes at the quarter pole, was asked top of the lane, responded to draw off convincingly, won in hand coming to the finish. CHOW WAGON settled in the second flight, saved ground throughout, asked top of the lane, hit stride mid stretch, was closing fast in deep stretch to gain the place position. CASSIUS CASEY set a pressured pace, vied in four way duel entering the stretch, was no match for the winner leaving the eighth pole, was out finished late and settled for the show position. RIGHT ON raced up close along the rail, was urged near the quarter pole, could not keep up from mid stretch, bested rest. SHAKEYOGROOVETHING trailed to top of the stretch, roused for the drive, picked up tired rivals, never menaced. DANCE FOR MILITARY stalked contested pace, almost drew even at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid and tired mid stretch, vanned off. BACK AGAIN tracked the pace to mid turn, bid four wide to loom at the quarter pole, battled to upper stretch, flattened out.
