**Footnotes**

ANEARLYBREEZE rushed shortly after the start taking over command, traveled towards the inside drawing off from the field, won easily being ridden out. PRINCESS NATALIE hopped at the break and trailed down the backside racing wide, made a bold run on the turn improving position, chased loose winner entering the stretch, never threatened that one but proved a game second best. TENDER ECHOS gave chase around the bend traveling three to four wide, bested rest never menacing in the drive. GRACELAND DIXIE lacked speed and trailed mid turn, swung five wide upper stretch, beat others never factoring. MARABELLE pressed the winner briefly, chased from the quarter pole and gave way mid stretch. HAPPY PARTY lacked speed running in the second flight, hard ridden entering the stretch, failed to respond. DEHERE AND NOW flashed speed giving chase along the rail, gave way leaving the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
