Footnotes

POLITICAL PROMISE well handled running in the second flight, gained coming to the half racing four wide, angled towards the rail mid turn when engaging SUSHINE SMOKEY for the lead, moved clear entering the stretch, was kept to task in deep stretch as the lead was diminishing holding safe to the finish line. BLUE KING settled towards the rear, asked mid turn, swung four wide into the stretch, closed strongly in deep stretch proving a willing second best. SUNSHINE SMOKEY opened a large advantage going to the half running in the three path, headed leaving the quarter pole but had no resistance for the winner, tired in the drive saving third place. HEAVENLY EXECUTIVE tracked the pace down the backside, asked for more leaving the far turn, lacked response never menacing. PORTOMASO raced four wide into the first turn, stalked then chased loose leader at the half, began to weaken from the quarter pole, no factor in the stretch drive. HOMBRECITO varied little running in the second flight, never threatened. SUPREME NOTION was outrun early, no factor. KAIZER TOP raced briefly in mid pack, faded after a half mile finishing well beaten. LITTLE BRUISER flashed speed chasing to the half, dropped off midway on the second turn finishing spent.
