PK'S GAL sent up to contest early on the inside, went head and head with ROYAL PET through the turn, battled inside of two rivals nearing the wire, gutted it out clearing late. CONQUER THE DAY laid close to the pace, tracked dueling rivals on the turn, loomed boldly abreast foes in mid drive, went all out to wire willingly. ROYAL PET sent hard pressing abreast PK'S GAL to the turn, battled in tandem into the stretch, collared from the outside by CONQUER THE DAY in mid drive, wore down between horses late. QUEENOFMOUNTAIN broke slowly from the gate, angled immediately to the rail, found stride near the 1/4 pole, closed after the fact along the inside. TORDUE gave early pursuit 4 wide, raced evenly through the turn into the lane, had no late surge. DATE TREE BAY a step slow off a quick pace, rushed up to leaders on the turn, leveled off entering the lane, gave way in drive. KISSINLEAF was always outrun finishing 7 wide. OPEN SESSION outrun early, was never involved. SAPPHIRE HILL came in crowding TONY'S GIRL at the start, raced wide with no response. TONY'S GIRL crowded by SAPPHIRE HILL leaving the gate, showed little after.
