Footnotes

SPIN THE WHEEL slow early circled out into upper stretch surging abreast rivals in the six path getting up in time. PERPETUITY a step slow in second flight angled to mid track in upper stretch responded with best stride a sixteenth out bidding gamely in the last yards. STAR SHEBA broke alertly dueling inside of A LITTLE GRAND through the turn, battling from the rail down the stretch would weaken late. A LITTLE GRAND broke sharply dueling abreast STAR SHEBA from the outset into upper stretch, extending in the three path would weaken late. MEADOW TRAIL tracked the pace through the turn looming from the four path in upper stretch, in range late had no surge. LALIQUE away slowly played no factor. BEA'S HARD SIX chased early then wavered on the turn fading into upper stretch. MYLLMONEYMAKER retreated on the turn. WHISPERING DIXIE was always outrun.
