SECOND CUP tucked in behind a quartet to duelers soon after the start, waited to the three sixteenths, surged through a narrow opening top of the lane skimming the rail, vied to mid stretch with a pair of rivals, slowly edged clear under strong handling in deep stretch. FAST WOLF showed good early speed, duled around the turn racing between foes, fought hard to deep stretch, ceded grudgingly proving a game second best. TOBERMORY was never far off the pace, moved up challenging for the lead at the quarter pole traveling three to four wide, battled to mid stretch then weakened late to settle for third place. WINBLAISEANDSHOW settled in the second flight saving ground, angled out in upper stretch, gave belated action improving placing but never menaced. HOPPER unhurried and trailed mid turn, gave best response in deep stretch, finished with interest but never threatened. SURFACTANT raced evenly in mid pack, roused to no avail, failed to threaten. SPICY JACK broke well pressing for the early lead running between foes, began to fade in upper stretch, used up. MAD AFTERSHOCK was hard used vying for the early lead, began to drop off entering the stretch, gave way inside the eighth pole. SULLY'S LANDING was always outrun, showed little. BLAZING CITY raced mid track in the second flight, gave way upper stretch, no factor.
