**Footnotes**

Q THE MUSIC pressed then chased KARAKORUM PIRATE through the turn, drew to leader from the inside in upper stretch then surged off under a left hand whip. KARAKORUM PIRATE broke sharply working a clear lead into the turn, engaged from the inside by Q THE MUSIC in upper stretch would be overpowered from the sixteenth pole. JEMARU slow early was outrun through the turn, had mild response in drive improving a bit near mid track. STRIKE JET chased early then dropped off the top pair on the turn, went evenly the rest of the way posing no menace. HAROLD'S TRIBUTE retreated on the turn. WADA ZANY DAY raced second flight tiring to upper stretch. ATLANTIC RIDER displayed poor action.
