ARATHORN away alertly set a pressured early pace, edged clear on the turn digging in from the three and four path down the lane drawing out late. PERFECT START sent hard pressured early then chased through the turn, extending in the two path upper stretch proved second best. FAISAL PRINCE tracked the pace moving evenly through the turn, angled four wide in upper stretch outbid the others. CLASS READY saved ground throughout gaining a bit into upper stretch finding no late surge along the rail. FRISCO EXSECTIVE slow early saved ground as no factor. FISH was never involved. VALIENT TENOBOB failed to respond. IMPETUOUS POWER was always outrun. SUNDAY MASS gave way on the turn.
