ACT TOO quickly showed in front, angled towards the rail setting all the pace, held sway late under heavy pressure to the finish line. PAPA VITO stalked around the bend racing three wide, was hard ridden from the furlong marker and responded to close in on the winner nearing the wire, settled for second place in a solid effort. BANDINI THE GREAT stalked the winner racing in hand along the rail, angled out entering the stretch, bid between foes inside the eighth pole looming off the winner, was outfinished late and settled for third best in a hard try. SURPRISE ATTACK was never far off the pace racing four wide around the turn, hard ridden giving chase from top of the stretch, lacked needed surge besting rest. VISION WITHINREACH raced evenly traveling three to four wide throughout, failed to respond when asked. KID KLARE lacked speed racing off the rail soon after the start, never factored. SILVER PIONEER trailed early on, offered little. SEMER'S LEGACY settled in the second flight racing along the rail to the quarter pole, swung wide under a drive top of the stretch, weakened in the lane never threatening.
