Footnotes

CAPE HATCHET sat patient laying close into the turn, pressed up three deep from the quarter pole taking charge in upper stretch moving off under a hand ride. FLIP FLOP sent to the top worked a short lead under pressure through the turn, overpowered by CAPE HATCHET in upper stretch would stay at it in the two path saving place. FOURTH TOP in close at the break was rushed in pursuit along the rail through the turn, began to waver in upper stretch dropping off weary. CHALLENGER away slowly was hustled four wide on the turn then three wide down the lane finishing evenly. MALKEINU chased early then dropped off on the turn, labored home from mid track. DREAM VICTORY slow early was always outrun. RUNNING WISH flashed early speed then retreated abruptly on the turn. An objection from the rider of FOURTH TOP against the rider of FLIP FLOP for interference at the break was disallowed.
