DEVILS LIGHTENING settled in mid pack, launched rally coming four wide into the stretch, vied abreast foes from the eighth pole, got up on the wire under an all out drive. FOUR AND FIVE RED hustled to the front, set the pace running off the rail, moved out wider entering the stretch, fought hard receiving strong encouragement, was out noddod on the wire missing in a game effort. NEWYORKJOE stalked the runner up from the start, angled towards the inside top of the lane when FOUR AND FIVE RED remained well off the rail, vied in a three way battle a sixteenth out, was outfinished by top pair to settle for third place. VALIDATED BLARNEY bid three wide racing between foes at the quarter pole, had to take up at the three sixteenths when FOUR AND FIVE RED drifted out to the four path, failed to regain momentum finishing evenly. GRANDMA'S PASSION moved to the rail shortly after the start, tracked to top of the lane, angled out under a drive, failed to respond besting rest. FOREST ICE came out late and rider lost right stirrup, regained iron going into the far turn running far behind, roused from the quarter pole, found stride upper stretch, finished strongly but was no real factor. BOREAUS broke well stalking the leader racing towards the inside, had little left by upper stretch, weakened to the wire. NATIONAL SECURITY raced evenly in the second flight, lacked response when asked. BREAKING FREE raced wide throughout, offered little. THE RIDER OF VALIDATED BLARNEY CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF FOUR AND FIVE RED FOR INTERFERENCE IN UPPER STRETCH, AFTER REVIEW, THIS CLAIM WAS DISMISSED.
