GREY MIRAGE was well rated, circled out to bid in upper stretch, drew even then was carried wide getting up gamely on the wire. SOCA TEMPO tracked early, bid to a short lead on the far turn, drifted out while dueling late, just missed. MILWAUKEE HIGH went evenly, varied little through the far turn, gave a mild rally down the lane. HIGH SIGN stalked early, was roused hard to upper stretch, hung in drive. TOBAR sent clear worked on pace, collared on the far turn would weaken the final eighth. RUN THE OTHER WAY played no factor. AL FAASIL raced second flight, was not involved. MY BUDDY DAN was bumped at the break, outrun. FASHIONABLE TIME offered little. ROVE stopped on the turn, was eased in upper stretch.
