READY VICTORY rushed to the lead, set a pressured pace, turned away FUN IN PARADISE leaving the quarter pole, drew off being ridden out for a convincing victory. FUN IN PARADISE broke well, bid at the quarter pole and vied with the winner for the lead, proved no match from mid stretch, held place in a game effort. JOE'S LAD pressed for the early lead, started to lose ground entering the stretch, was no menace in the lane while besting rest. TRIPPINGLY settled along the rail in mid pack, hard ridden into the stretch, failed to threaten. LEGIONARY lacked speed racing towards the rear, did mildly improve placing but never factored. COSTLY COUNT was in tight briefly brushing with MOUNTAIN LEGEND shortly after the start, raced wide in the second flight, offered little. MOUNTAIN LEGEND was hustled leaving the gate and brushed COSTLY COUNT in the early going, chased the winner to mid turn, faded top of the stretch, spent. PURPLE SUNRISE was always outrun, never involved. GRANS FRISCO made a steady fade from mid turn, stopped in mid stretch finishing well beaten.
