UMBANI was perfectly placed for the run down the backside, bid three wide near the guarter pole to vie for the lead, edged clear in upper stretch, was hard ridden to prevail. TRUE REBEL was a step slow into stride, settled in the second flight racing well off the rail, rallied six wide from upper stretch, surged nearing the wire to just miss in a game effort. EVAN'S EMERALD unhurried from the bate, trailed to mid turn, gained momentum past the quarter pole, swung six to seven wide upper stretch, finished strongly but too late. IRISH GENTLEMAN tracked running towards the inside to the quarter pole, moved out to the five path upper stretch, loomed with a furlong to go traveling between foes, was outfinished vying for a minor award. FUNKY COUNTRY broke sharply and angled towards the rail, set a pressured pace throughout, fought hard to mid stretch, faded late in a hard try. TEXAS HOLLADAY was a step slow leaving the gate, hustled up to track under a rating, asked from the quarter pole, lacked needed response. FAST FASHION showed good speed to vie for the early lead, matched strides to the quarter pole, had enough and gave way mid stretch. SNOWBOARD RIDGE rated early racing between foes around the bend, lacked rally when roused, never threatened. AWESOME AFFAIR raced briefly in mid pack, faded from mid turn, swung very wide entering the stretch, showed little. U S TREASURY was always outrun, never involved.
