SASSY MISS CATHY dueled abreast foes racing four wide, led running three wide entering the stretch, was under an all out drive to prevail just holding on. FRIENDLY MISS settled towards the rear, swung six wide upper stretch, closed stoutly nearing the wire, just missed in a hard effort. FAIR CHASE dueled running between foes early, dropped off mid turn, swung out giving chase upper stretch, drifted wider mid stretch under left handed stick, outgamed late. GRANDE BOLD dueled between foes early, battled along the rail with the winner mid stretch, ceded grudgingly in deep stretch, hard try. BURNING AMOR lacked speed racing mid track, swung seven wide top of the lane, surged belatedly improving placing but never threatened. SHESASUPERFREAK was hard used vying for the early lead, dropped off a bit top of the lane, needed more late. MACHO CORAZON unhurried and trailed down the backside, showed little. LEE ANNE'S WAY tracked a contested pace traveling four wide, began to fade entering the stretch, used up. DON'T TELL ME THAT raced along the rail throughout, gave way near the quarter pole, finished being eased across the wire.
