Footnotes

FANTOM EXECUTIVE raced up close from the start, bid three wide midway on the turn, collared STRONG AS STONE entering the stretch, edged clear inside the eighth pole and increased margin late under strong handling. TENCATI unhurried early and raced mid track while trailing, swung six wide top of the lane, hit best stride mid stretch, closed strongly just getting up for second place. STRONG AS STONE broke sharply and set a pressured pace, battled with the winner to mid stretch, weakened late and was just headed losing second place in last jumps, game try. SOME KIND OF MAGIC well placed tracking a contested pace, roused from the quarter pole, gave chase in the lane but lacked needed surge. LAZY NATHAN showed good speed from the gate, vied running between foes to mid turn, started to drop off entering the stretch, no threat from mid stretch. RISING THUNDER lacked speed and trailed running along the rail around the bend, failed to factor. KILLIAN'S GLORY settled in mid pack, hard ridden from the quarter pole, failed to respond and weakened in the lane. CITY CODE lacked speed racing in the second flight, dropped off entering the stretch, no factor.
