Footnotes

MAJESTY'S LASS taken back under a snug hold, sat patient to the 1/2 mile pole, circled out and gave a roused advance from the 1/4 pole into the stretch, swept up on the outside of weary pacesetters powering clear. JEANIE SUE unhurried and tucked inside, rated along for a 1/2 mile, prompted to bid inside the 3/8 pole, surged up the rail late to salvage place. JOANIE'S JETT broke well, tracked close up racing between horses down the backside, extended the bid from the 1/4 pole to the stretch, overpowered by MAJESTY'S LASS near the 1/8 pole, hung tough late finishing well. TISOURLTURN sent to the front end from the gate, pressed a short lead abreast BUMPER TO BUMPER down the backside, pushed hard to keep lead racing on the final turn, overwhelmed from the outside by MAJESTY'S LASS in upper stretch, wore down gradually through the drive. BRAVEHEARTED LADY raced evenly along the inside, tried to mount a bid leaving the backside, edged somewhat closer nearing the 1/4 pole, proved no real contender. NINE TU TU'S hustled close up, followed the pace 4 wide on the backside, hard ridden while continuing to lose ground through the final turn, wore out in mid drive giving way. LADY DRAMA bobbled soon after the start, was never a player. BUMPER TO BUMPER sent inside to contest the pace, couldn't get by TISOURLTURN from the backstretch to the 1/4 pole, had enough entering the lane folding up. REMEMBER BRIAN was always outrun. CHRISTMAS TABLE rated at mid pack, mounted a 5 wide bid on the final turn, flattened out at the head of the stretch.
