JEANIE SUE well placed out of the opening turn, stalked 4 wide to the far turn, loomed when roused at the 1/4 pole, drew even abreast rivals in upper stretch, went fully extended to get up late. IN MY TIME broke alertly to go on the pace, stalked ALASKAN GLORY while saving ground through the backside, prompted to action leaving the far turn, battled on even terms from the rail through the lane, out gamed in the final stride. ALASKAN GLORY sent clear from the break, went measured on slow splits to the far turn, set down when challenged near the 1/4 pole, collared between horses through the lane, ceded grudgingly in final yards. KYLOR CREEK unhurried from the gate, moved evenly racing on the inside, varied little through the far turn, responded inside the 1/8 pole, came on late finishing well. BOOM BOOM CHA CHA off slowly, tucked inside going in hand down the backside, prompted to action angling 4 wide advancing on the far turn, loomed on the outside of a trio of leaders in upper stretch, flattened out under the whip. OGLE went evenly in second flight, had no surge under asking. SOBER MOMENT was always outrun. CANDY CANE C C hustled out pursuing 3 wide into the backstretch, used to keep up following ALASKAN GLORY to the 1/2 mile pole, wavered into the far turn, had nothing left at the 1/4 pole. BROWNS VELVET struggled throughout.
