YANKEE CAREER quickly showed in front, angled towards the inside and set all the pace, increased margin in the stretch, won in control being ridden out. JEMARU broke well stalking the winner from the start, never threatened while holding place position in a game effort. SAGUARO FLATS lacked speed racing in the second flight, angled to the rail near the quarter pole, finished in willing manner picking up third place. MAGICAL BRAVADO settled in mid pack, made a bold four wide run mid turn, chased the winner entering the stretch, leveled off at the eighth pole. PULPIT'S JET raced evenly at mid track, swung six wide upper stretch, mildly improved placing but never threatened. ME BIG CHIEF well placed tracking the pace running along the inside, angled out to the three path under a drive top of the lane, came up empty in the stretch run. DANCE FOR JOY was a step slow into stride, angled out a bit top of the lane, failed to menace. BEAST BOY raced evenly in the second flight, mildly bid at the quarter pole, flattened out tin the drive. BIG DIESEL trailed running at mid track, never involved. DADDY CAT flashed brief foot, gave way coming to the quarter pole, finished weary.
