RED ONION LADY tucked in behind a pair of duelers soon after the start, sat patient to the quarter pole, moved off the rail turning for home, bid three wide upper stretch, vied abreast rivals from the eighth pole, drew off late under strong handling. MISS HORSE DOCTOR battled for the lead from the start, vied racing between foes mid stretch, was no match for RED ONION LADY in deep stretch while proving a game second best. SNAKEINTHEGRASS sent hard, alternated for the lead racing along the rail, battled hard to deep stretch, weakened late in a good try. LENI'S JOY was forwardly placed traveling four wide around the turn, loomed under a stiff drive mid stretch, lacked needed late surge besting rest. TETON VISTA settled in mid pack, put to a drive leaving the quarter pole, chased in the stretch but failed to menace. BRIGHT HARBORLITES raced evenly in the second flight, swung seven wide upper stretch under a drive, lacked response never threatening. CANADIAN QUEEN lacked speed traveling in the second flight throughout, never factored. SENSE OF URGENCY was always outrun racing along the rail, showed little. EXCESSIVELY BRIGHT was a step slow into stride, never involved. SKIFF'S PRINCESS hustled and raced briefly in mid pack, made a steady fade leaving the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
