SUMMERLUCKY well rated while saving ground fired on the far turn advancing to collar ANGLE TO WIN in upper stretch, proving strong late would edge away near the rail. STREATERVILLE stalked the early pace rousing to action four deep into the far turn, pressed to even terms dueling abreast rivals through the lane ceding to SUMMERLUCKY while out gaming ANGLE TO WIN for place. ANGLE TO WIN sent clear set a modest pace through the far turn, collared between horses in upper stretch would extend coming up a bit short. GRAND SCALE settled early gave a prompted middle move to contention looming boldly through the far turn, asked for more in upper stretch would waver late under the whip. CASSIUS CASEY stalked the pace moving close up to the half, dropped off on the far turn then finished evenly along the rail. CAVALRY N' GOLD was never involved. LOWTHERS HILL rated early would fail to respond when prompted. HOOK ME NOW offered little. LAUGHING BRAVE acting up would miss the break, rushed off the pace was done after a half mile.
