CART'S MAYBEOUGHTA sent clear worked the lead through the turn into upper stretch, dug in there holding firm to wire. NEVEREVERYIELD went evenly, advanced on the turn, extended in drive would save place. CAST NO SHADOW lost ground, came very wide to upper stretch, bid gamely late. VALID DANCER was hustled out, chased through the turn, looming down the lane hung late. YOYO JABO slow early varied little through the turn, raced wide late gaining ground. POT LIMIT hustled close up, chased into upper stretch then weakened late. MEADOWMINER a step slow played no factor. HORIZONTAL IRV was never involved. STACK STEP broke slowly, labored. NATIVE APPROVAL was always outrun.
