Footnotes

WANTA GO rated nicely traveling off the rail going down the backside, bid three wide mid turn, dueled running between foes at the quarter pole, edged clear mid stretch while remaining at mid track and increased advantage late under steady handling. MAKE A TOAST rated from the start, moved off the rail entering the first turn, bid in tandem leaving the far turn, vied running four wide and abreast foes at the quarter pole, was no match for the winner in the final furlong proving a game second best. IRISH DIXIE settled early traveling towards the rear, urged mid turn but failed to respond, finally found stride mid stretch, finished strongly getting the nod for third place. AFLEET LEXI rushed a three to four wide middle move to vie for the lead at the half, inched clear on the bend, battled to top of the stretch, gave way at the eighth pole and was nosed out of third place in last jump. KUHLU hustled to the front, was headed by AFLEET LEXI going to the half, battled to the quarter pole, had enough and gave way top of the stretch. CHICKABUNNY lacked speed racing towards the rear throughout, offered little. THREE SIXTY tracked to the half, gave way midway on the second turn finishing well beaten.
