Footnotes

RAYWICK was bumped by KAYS CAT shortly after the start, settled in the second flight, hit stride leaving the quarter pole, came eight wide into the lane, collared SAFAYOSELF inside the furlong marker, quickly drove clear to win going away. SEFAYOSELF tracked racing well off the rail, rallied seven wide and took the lead briefly between calls, was no match for RAYWICK in deep stretch, proved a game second best. BOMBER BEAU tracked along the rail on the turn, angled to split foes upper stretch, finished willingly for a minor award. HIBACHI unhurried early, raced well off the rail throughout, rallied eight wide entering the stretch, chased from mid stretch, needed more late. BONNRITA raced wide throughout, slightly gain upper stretch, leveled off. KAYS CAT broke out to bump RAYWICK at the start, quickly rushed to press, took the lead mid turn, headed leaving the quarter pole, gave way mid stretch. BYCARBS DESTINY hustled to track early, raced between foes throughout, hard ridden in the drive, failed to threaten. HIGHLAND JAN sent hard, set a pressured pace, vied to the quarter pole, gave way top of the stretch, used up. RAHY'S BACHELOR pressed down the backside, raced inside on the bend, chased under a drive, gave way top of the stretch.
