MR. LUMP was always up close stalking a contested pace, angled to bid running three wide top of the lane, vied in a five way battle mid stretch, edged clear and held sway under a drive to the finish. CASH ME OUT well placed, tracked a contested pace, came five wide and between foes upper stretch, vied abreast rivals mid stretch, was out gamed by the winner late, proved a game second best. HACODA settled in the second flight, rallied six wide top of the lane, finished in willing manner. WONDROUS ZEAL vied early, was headed form both sides shortly after the start, raced up close throughout, ceded mid stretch, hard effort. DANGEL raced evenly along the inside, sat patient to top of the lane, angled wide and was going well at the finish. RARE DEPUTY raced up close early on, traveled five wide on the bend, loomed mid stretch, tired late. LIONEL'S BOY sent hard, vied while four wide and between foes at the quarter pole, began to weaken mid stretch. RIGHT GIRLS STAR was hustled along, dueled throughout, angled to the rail top of the lane, battled to the eighth pole, faded a sixteenth out. JUDGE LOUIE was always outrun, raced wide. HEBE A GENIUS lacked speed, saved ground to no avail, never factored.
