Footnotes

BERYL'S WAY rushed shortly after the start to vie for the lead, went clear mid turn, was challenged by OPEN AGENDA entering the stretch, remained well off the rail for the stretch run, held firm late under strong encouragement. OPEN AGENDA settled early, rushed a four wide move mid turn, loomed off the winner turning for home, was turned away inside the eighth pole finishing a willing second best. MIAMI'S SECRET rated early, asked from the quarter pole, came four wide chasing the top pair in upper stretch, leveled off needing more late. D'CHEETAH well placed from the start, was hard ridden mid turn, lacked response and drifted a bit inward top of the lane, failed to threaten. FORTY NINTH N PARK lacked speed and trailed racing along the rail to the quarter pole, swung out under a drive upper stretch, improved placing but failed to menace. SUCH THOUGHTS broke alertly and dueling with the winner briefly, began to drop off in upper stretch, no late factor. JET STREAM lacked speed running towards the rear throughout at mid track, swung wider in upper stretch, failed to factor. MISTY'S IDENTITY varied little running in the second flight, showed little. CAMU flashed good early foot, stalked to mid turn, steadily faded from top of the stretch.
